Notes:

(1) Matches were run over 9 heats, with a 4-2-1 scoring system;

(2) The first match between Nottingham and West Ham was awarded as a 36-0 victory to the visitors as Nottingham had temporarily closed down;

(3) The second match between Coventry and Crystal Palace originally ended 26-36, but was amended due to an oversized tyre used by visiting rider George Newton;

(4) The second match between Crystal Palace and West Ham originally ended in a 32-30 win for West Ham; however, the match was declared void by the ACU.
