This was advertised as the First Dirt Track meeting in Britain "run as is done in Australia". Attendance figures vary from 10,000 to 20,000. The meeting ran for 5 hours. Organiser South Manchester Motor Club. Billy Galloway and Keith MacKay gave broadsiding exhibitions but due to a surface that was too hard it was not possible to put up a really spectacular display. The technique was no faster than riding around the bends "feet up". Track Length half mile to the lap.

Attendance 6,000-10,000.

Two meetings were held. One in the afternoon with a futher fixture in the evening. The track had not had sufficient watering and was a dust bowl. There was a collision between T Rosier and Joe Palastrand. Rosier bruised his leg and tore a thigh muscle. In a wheel to wheel battle with C. Tattersall, Clem Beckett fell and went across Tattersall who swerved to avoid him. Beckett was lucky to escape with bruises. R.Hooton had bad cuts to his face.
