At the resumed inquest held on 26<sup>th</sup> August 1931 into the death of James Kenny at the meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> August, the Manchester County Coroner's jury returned a verdict of accidental death due to the unsafe condition of the unlicensed track. The Coroner remarked that this was the third fatality he had dealt with at the track. The jury recommended to the Coroner that the track should be closed until it was put in a safe condition. (*Sheffield Daily Telegraph 27<sup>th</sup> August 1931*)
