TWO late 5-1s from Henry Atkins and Dan Gilkes wrapped up Plymouth's first victory of the season at the end of a meeting raced through at top speed in drizzly conditions.

The Centurions' top two team- rode Belle Vue's Harry McGurk out of contention in both Heats 13 and 15 to fend off the Colts' resistance with the visitors having led in the early stages.

Gilkes came' to grief in Heat 1, although partner Connor King prevented serious damage by winning the re-run.

Those turned out to be the only points dropped by the home No. 1, whilst Atkins was unbeaten after losing out to McGurk in Heat 4.

McGurk took two of the visitors' four wins, with Nathan Ablitt and Jack Smith also successful early in the meeting, but their only later advantage came when Richard Andrews fell in Heat 9.

Gilkes, who had also been unbeaten at the NSS for Kent last season, reeled off five wins out of five but with Richard Andrews (work) and Adam Extance (Covid) both absent from the middle order, his only real support came from reserve Ben Trigger.

The Colts coped with the absence of the unwell Jack Parkinson-Blackburn, whilst Connor Coles enjoyed a good meeting for his old club as he stood in for Nathan Ablitt who was racing for Poole.

Gilkes got the better of opposite number Jack Smith on three occasions, whilst for the home side there were impressive displays from both McGurk brothers and youngster Freddy Hodder took his first race win at this level.

Kyle Bickley and Greg Blair both scored paid maximums for the Bullets, and the latter did so with a series of exciting moves from the back. He made it past Sam McGurk and Jack Smith to take Heat 5 before surpassing that in Heat 9 with a spectacular last lap with saw him first go round Archie Freeman and then take Harry McGurk on the run to the line.

By this time, the home side were 12 points up with the Colts struggling to provide race winners, as only Nathan Ablitt and reserve Freddy Hodder got them on the board in that respect.

After Bickley and Luke Crang surged either side of Smith in Heat 13, the remaining interest was over Blair's paid maximum, which was secured with more overtaking in Heats 14 and 15, the latter at the expense of Smith and Ablitt who he passed on the line.

AS the Thompson twins dominated proceedings it was hard not to feel a little sympathy for Belle Vue, for whom everything went wrong at one of the toughest away venues.
 There were untroubled maximums for both Dan and Joe Thompson, with Dan lowering his own track record — and remarkably the times in all four of his races which ran all for all four laps were within a window of 0.13 of a second.
 Connor Coles added three wins of his own, and amongst a solid middle and lower order there was an entertaining debut from 15-year-old Max Perry who won his first ride and picked up many points from the back.
 Colts captain Jack Smith fell on the last lap of Heat 1 and then came to grief far more heavily in Heat 5 when he over-slid on the exit of turn two and clattered the fence as he tried to pass Tom Spencer.
 Smith was withdrawn but the incidents didn't end there with Nathan Ablitt involved in three incidents, including an awkward tangle with Perry in Heat 12, whilst Sam McGurk improved as the meeting went on but ended on the deck himself in the final race.

BELLE Vue completely dominated this one-sided encounter and dropped just six points all evening against an Armadale outfit hit by illness and unavailability.

The Devils arrived Without William Lawson and Gregor Millar due to Covid and George Rothery after a work injury, whilst the likes of Danny Phillips, Tom Woolley and guest Connor Coles on his old home track were unable to make an impression.

The Colts would have topped the 70-point mark but for a spectacular fall for Sam McGurk in Heat 5, and their only other last place came from Archie Freeman in Heat 7 - but he was otherwise unbeaten in his remaining three rides.

Each of the last eight races resulted in 5-1s to the rampant Colts, with the highlight being Freddy Hodder's effort in Heat 12 to pass the far more experienced Woolley and team up with Nathan Ablitt.

There was a full 18-point maximum for home captain Jack Smith, whilst Harry McGurk was paid for the lot from his six outings, and Ablitt reeled off a 15-point maximum on his home debut. It may well turn out to be the biggest team total we see in the sport this season.

WHEN the 2022 season reviews are written, one of the prominent questions will concern how exactly a Belle Vue team packed with such talented youngsters somehow didn't manage to make it into the play-offs.

Defeat at strugglers Plymouth was partly explainable by the Centurions clearly being at their strongest in the early part of the season; but defeat at Armadale in a fixture where the Colts required just one league point to make it into the top four was a disaster of epic proportions. There was a gaping hole in the Belle Vue team where Nathan Ablitt would normally be found, with 'work commitments' being cited as the reason - although as a rider aged 18 or under, if that had been declared with three days' notice, the Colts would have been entitled to operate rider replacement, which might just have made the difference.

None of that should detract from a terrific Devils performance or a great effort by the Armadale track staff to get the meeting on after heavy rain earlier in the day.

The efforts of their team were doubtless cheered just as loudly in Oxford who stood to gain greatly from the Colts' slip-up.

An eventful contest ensued given the conditions, but the experience of Lee Complin and Danny Phillips was of vital importance, along with a best display of the season from Josh Embleton who was involved in two early 5-1s to set the tone.

And despite the efforts of Jake Mulford, who won his first four rides, the Colts fell short with their night summed up by two races in particular: Heat 4, when the Devils' Tom Woolley had fallen whilst leading and yet they still took a 3-0 as Freddy Hodder and Harry McGurk both failed to finish the re-runs; and Heat 13, with the gap at five points, when Complin passed Jack Smith who fell, whilst McGurk came to a stop, and the hosts put it beyond their opponents with a 5-1.
