SAM Masters opened the senior season at Armadale with a paid maximum — and already looks set to form a powerful combination with fellow heat leader Josh Pickering.

The two Aussies combined for 5-1s in Heats 13 and 15 with Pickering promoted to No. 5 this season, and the Monarchs were pleased with their overall display o fend off a stubborn Bandits side.

Lasse Fredriksen won Heat 8 ahead of Jye Etheridge on his debut, and Paco Castagna marked his first appearance for the club with a race win too in a fierce scrap with Ricky Wells in Heat 9.

The Bandits, for whom ex- Monarch Theo Pijper offered good support to Wells and Chris Harris, needed a 3-3 from the last race for a league point, but Pickering produced a terrific ride to storm round Harris and join Masters upfront.

BERWICK recorded a second convincing home win of the season, with all seven riders claiming at least one paid win and Jye Etheridge again excelling at reserve.
 The Monarchs were limited to just four race wins and found themselves 16 points down after eight races in a total reversal of last year's fixture when the Armadale men ran riot.
 After back-to-back Berwick 5- 15, there was some hope for Edinburgh in Heat 9 with Josh Pickering passing Theo Pijper on the last bend for a maximum advantage with Sam Masters — but Chris Harris and Ty Proctor instantly hit back, before Masters was disqualified from Heat 11 after clashing with Etheridge on the first turn, with the result being another Berwick 5-1.
 The visitors' night was summed up when Pickering clipped the fence in Heat 15 with his bike careering across the track into Paco Castagna, who was replaced by Masters for the re-run which was taken by the impressive Ricky Wells.

Monarchs duo Paco Castagna and Kye Thomson had failed to shine to that stage, but they took e shock 5-1 over Matthew Wethers and guest Chris Harris — and there was no Diamonds comeback as Sam Masters controlled Heats 11 and 13, and home reserve Lee Complin came to grief in Heat 12.

Masters was unbeaten from his first four rides but Max Clegg came to the party in the closing stages with wins in Heats 14 and 15, the latter denying his former team-mate a maximum..

THE Monarchs had three unbeaten riders and very little difficulty in securing their quarter-final spot, although the final margin was a little harsh on the Diamonds. Despite their lack of race wins — Matthew Wethers their only successful rider in Heat 5 when he got the better of Kye Thomson — the visitors had held the gap on the night to eight points with five races remaining. But Edinburgh's aggregate position was already as good as safe, and they completed the meeting with a 4-2 and then four successive 5-1s, with reserve James Sarjeant taking centre stage with a paid maximum alongside top two Sam Masters and Josh Pickering. The Monarchs' big guns did have to work for their full pay packets after fending off Wethers in Heat 13 and then team-riding another ex-Edinburgh man Max Clegg out in the last race. There was also a paid win for Jacob Hook in Heat 14, with Newcastle's problems increasing by the absence of heat leader Paul Starke due to food poisoning.

EDINBURGH had no complaints after Glasgow stormed to their best Armadale result for six years and made a firm statement of intent — both in the Scottish derby and in the Championship as a whole.
 The usual Monarchs top two of Sam Masters and Josh Pickering were up staged by former Edinburgh No. 1 Craig Cook, and Ulrich Ostergaard made a successful return to the track where he was seriously hurt last season.
 Key to the meeting was the Tigers' Winning run in Heats 5—7, with two 5-1s and a 4-2, and the hero in that respect was Danyon Hume who took a stunning win over Masters in Heat 6 and then came into the next race when Ben Basso broke the tapes, and promptly won that one as well with Ostergaard completing a shock maximum over Pickering.
 Ostergaard and Basso then put the visitors 14 points to the good at the expense of Masters in Heat 10, and Cook neutralised the pairing of the Monarchs top two with the tactical substitute in play in the next, which all but confirmed victory.
 Cook's first defeat came in Heat 13 but this time it was Tom Brennan up of Masters, and late wins for Kyle Thomson and Masters - after two from Paco Castagna - were limited consolation for the defeated hosts.

THIS second leg always promised a dramatic story either way, especially with the back - story of the Monarchs travelling without their top two due to a Polish fixture clash, and fighting tooth and nail to defend a 16-point lead.

But the stories that emerged were really at the top and bottom of the Glasgow riding order, as Craig Cook endured a mechanical nightmare which saw him fail to finish his first three rides, whilst Broc Nicol scored a four-ride paid maximum at reserve leaving home fans questioning his non-inclusion in Heat 14.

Cook suffered a clutch failure in Heat 1, a snapped chain in Heat 6, and a blown engine when leading Heat 10, handling the Monarchs a 5-1 from Kye Thomson and Paco Castagna which served to cancel out a similar result from Connor Bailey and Nicol two races earlier.

That meant with five races remaining Edinburgh had a ten-point aggregate lead intact, with Richard Lawson and Justin Sedgman doing enough to cover Sam Masters and Josh Pickering - Sedgman winning Heats 6 and 9 after conceding a 5-1 in Heat 4.

No change in Heat 11 as Lawson and Dillion Ruml packed in behind Tom Brennan, but Glasgow were given a glimmer of hope when Kye Thomson crashed out in Heat 12, thankfully avoiding serious injury, and after lengthy delay for fence repairs, Nicol and Ulrich Ostergaard completed a 5-1 in the re-run.

And when Cook, on his second bike, teamed up with Brennan for a 5-1 over the Monarchs' guests in Heat 13, the aggregate gap was down to two, and all momentum appeared to be with Glasgow.

Tigers fans will continue to debate the absence of Nicol from Heat 14, although it wouldn't have immediately been clear which rider to replace as Benjamin Basso had scored only three points beforehand but did win the race whilst Danyon Hume, with wins in Heats 2 and 7, was left at the back as a 3-3 resulted.

So all outcomes were possible ahead of Heat 15, and three laps in it looked like an aggregate tie and Golden Heats to decide it after Cook passed Lawson to lead, whilst the previously unbeaten Brennan held third place.

But this derby classic had one final twist in the tale with Sedgman, a man sacked by the Tigers late last season, coming back to haunt them by moving inside Brennan on the second bend of lap four to send another of his former clubs delightedly into the semi-finals.

Edinburgh took the advantage from an incident-strewn first leg with Josh Pickering and Sam Masters both scoring maximums, whilst the Bears were limited to just three race wins.

The biggest blow for the visitors came when they lost Lewis Kerr in a dramatic Heat 9 incident, which saw him tangle with Kye Thomson on turns three and four after the two had charged inside Paco Castagna, with the Italian and Kasper Andersen both also becoming involved. But in fairness a decent home win already looked on the cards as the Monarchs were already 14 points ahead by that stage, having taken their first 5-1 in a re-run of Heat 2 which featured a three-man pile-up in the initial staging between Jacob Hook and Bears duo Andersen and Kyle Newman, with Andersen taking a particularly heavy fall after being collected by the riders inside him.

Guest No.1 Aaron Summers took Redcar's first win in Heat 5 but the hosts responded with three successive 4-2s, Heat 8 requiring a re-run after a first-bend clash between Lasse Fredriksson and Andersen which saw the Norwegian rider come down - whilst at the second attempt, Newman failed to leave the start due to mechanical failure.

Redcar rallied after the loss of Kerr and managed to share Heats 9 to 11, all of which were won by home riders, and the visitors gained a foothold in the tie when Newman joined Charles Wright for a 5-1 in Heat 12 as Thomson retired.

But Edinburgh will always look at Heat 13 and 15 in home matches especially as providing the potential for significant gains, and so t proved once more.

Pickering and Masters gated to a maximum in Heat 13 over Summers and Andersen, before Newman prevented a further home advantage from Heat 14 with an early pass on James Sarjeant around the outside.

But Summers and Wright had nothing for Pickering and Masters in Heat 15 as the Monarchs opened the lead to the widest it had been throughout the meeting, giving them a far stronger position to take to the Ecco Arena than in recent KO Cup tie between the clubs.

The Bears set off like a train, leading 17-7 after just four races but each time the hosts graded track, after Heats 4 and 7, it seemed to break Redcar's momentum and the Monarchs immediately emerged from each break with crucial 5-1s, with Lasse Fredriksen involved each time, which ultimately took the tie beyond the home side.

Sam Masters led the way for Edinburgh with 13, beaten only by Riss and Anderson, while the all action Pickering would have netted double figures but for a last corner fall when chasing Charles Wright in Heat 4.

Riss and Wright won their opening two races but both tailed off as the meeting progressed.

WHETHER it was a case of Leicester all fired up after their collapse at Poole, or Edinburgh having a collective nightmare at the worst possible time - or something in between — will never be fully established, but the outcome was the Lions as good as putting the semi-final to bed in the first leg.

The visitors had won at Armadale by 11 points in mid-May but nobody expected anything like a similar result this time around, let alone an wider margin of victory.

The tone was set when Nick Morris outgated Sam Masters in Heat 1 and the home skipper then overslid on turn three enabling Connor Mountain to shoot through and then ride a fine race to maintain second place.

And although Josh Pickering stormed inside Kyle Howarth to win Heat 4 with Jacob Hook winning a close fight with Max Clegg for third place, the Morris/Mountain combination did more damage to the Monarchs with their second 5-1 of the night in the next.

The Lions heat leaders largely controlled proceedings with Mountain and Clegg offering vital support, and it was that combination who raced an unchallenged 5-0 in Heat 8 which all-but put matters beyond the home side even at that early stage.

At the first time of asking, Lasse Fredriksen ploughed into the fence on turn three, and in the re-run Hook came down on the first bend after being expertly clamped by Clegg, and there was no real controversy over the referee's decision to eject the Australian.

Leicester's run of five successive race wins was ended by Masters in Heat 10 but there was no advantage back as Dan Thompson passed Fredriksen for third, before the Lions marched on with two 4-2s to extend the margin to 17 points.

That meant it was imperative, if Edinburgh were to even have a slim chance, for their big guns to fire in 5-1s in Heats 13 and 15, something Masters and Pickering achieved in the first of those assignments prior to a shared Heat 14 in which Clegg completed a fine night's work with another win.

But it was the Lions who would have the final say as Howarth gated in Heat 15 whilst Richie Worrall forced his way inside Sam Masters - and the biggest threat thereafter was from the two Leicester riders to each other with Howarth unaware of the faster Worrall behind him.

ON another occasion the withdrawal of No. 1 Nick Morris after a freak Heat 1 accident could have had serious consequences for Leicester, but as things turned out it was a setback they could take in their stride.

With the comfort blanket of a 17- point aggregate lead and the use of the IRR facility after Morris suffered lower back pain when he looped after a clutch plate broke, this was still almost mission impossible for Edinburgh against a side so comfortable on their home track.

Kyle Howarth and Richie Worrall both won their IRR rides as boss Stewart Dickson sought to wrap up the tie as soon as possible, and it was secured with a surprise 5-1 in Heat 9 when Dan Thompson produced a great ride to shock Josh Pickering down the inside going into lap two, with Worrall out in front.

There was some fine racing throughout with Max Clegg snatching second place on the line from James Sarjeant in Heat 2, and Thompson making a last lap pass on Paco Castagna in the next race.

Sam Masters reeled off four straight wins for the Monarchs, defeating Worrall in Heat 5 and Howarth in Heat 11 whilst the spectacular Pickering couldn't quite get on terms with Howarth when they met in their opening two outings.

Just as at Armadale on Friday, there was a consolation 5-1 for the Monarchs in Heat 13, and what a race it proved to be as Masters led from the start whilst Pickering first passed Thompson, who was taking the IRR, and then stormed inside Howarth going into the final two bends.

The big guns put on another fine show in Heat 15 but this time Masters lost out on his maximum, being squeezed to the back and sensibly bailing out of a moment with Worrall which could have become far too tight on the back straight, whilst Howarth held off Pickering out front. Edinburgh rode better than on Friday and were unfortunate to lose Lasse Fredriksen, who was taken down by the stray bike of Morris in Heat 1, although they did enjoy a stroke of luck in Heat 10 when Connor Mountain stopped whilst on a clear 5-1 with Worrall.

The conclusion is probably something most would have accepted beforehand: that the Monarchs have been the fourth-best team in the Championship this season, nothing to be ashamed of in itself, although they will feel a sense of regret that they were unable to show their best in this semi at a time when Leicester could have been under pressure.
