THIS was a sadly predictable mismatch with Glasgow having three unbeaten riders and dishing out Newcastle's third 60-plus thrashing on the road so far this season.

Tigers boss Cami Brown accepted the Diamonds had their problems, with Paul Starke unfortunate on his return to his old club, but the visitors managed to share just two of the 15 races and couldn't provide a single race win.

That statistic could have changed in Heat 10 when Max Clegg and James Wright gated in front, but Cook went from last to first and hit the front going into the third lap on his way to a 15- point full house.

Ulrich Ostergaard was also paid for the lot from five rides, holding off James Wright in Heat 15, and Ben Basso completed a debut paid maximum along with three 5-1s with Ostergaard — with Tom Brennan and Connor Bailey also paid for double figures in this one-sided encounter.

GLASGOW showed impressive strength-in-depth in this comfortable home win with reserve Connor Bailey unbeaten after dropping a point in Heat 2.

Jye Etheridge took that race for the Bandits but those were his only points of the night, and Bailey went on to share in two 5-1s, including an excellent Heat 12 when he edged out Theo Pijper on the line after a race-long scrap.

At the top of the order, Craig Cook dropped a point to Ty Proctor in Heat 1 but won each of his battles with opposite number Chris Harris, whilst Ulrich Ostergaard and Tom Brennan both won two races.

The Bandits gave Harris a tactical substitute ride in Heat 9, but Benjamin Basso hit the front for the Tigers who held a 4-2 before Harris passed Ostergaard.

Harris took his second win at the expense of the thrusting Brennan in Heat 11 while Danyon Hume held back Proctor for third. Hume added a win of his own in Heat 14 to compensate for Basso's last place.

ALWAYS a feisty encounter due to the obvious connection between the clubs, and Stewart Dickson was left smiling over his Glasgow successor Cami Brown after another strong home display from the Lions.

With Benjamin Basso winning his opening two rides, the Tigers kept things tight and only trailed by two points at the halfway stage - and they would have been level but for Richie Worrall passing Ulrich Ostergaard in Heat 7.

Leicester pulled clear in the next three races with Joe Thompson getting the better of Broc Nicol on the last lap of Heat 8, and a 5-1 from Nick Morris and Connor Mountain took them 10-up after Heat 10 when Ostergaard crashed out.

Brown elected to use his tactical substitute in Heat11 with Tom Brennan, but he and Craig Cook were frustrated by track specialist Worrall, and that left the Tigers chasing a league point at best.

However, after a Lions 4-2 in Heat 13 when Cook did well to split Worrall and Morris, Leicester wrapped things up with a dramatic Heat 14 5-1 when the Thompson twins combined to re-pass Basso after the Dane had shot between them at the end of the third lap.

EDINBURGH had no complaints after Glasgow stormed to their best Armadale result for six years and made a firm statement of intent — both in the Scottish derby and in the Championship as a whole.

The usual Monarchs top two of Sam Masters and Josh Pickering were up staged by former Edinburgh No. 1 Craig Cook, and Ulrich Ostergaard made a successful return to the track where he was seriously hurt last season.

Key to the meeting was the Tigers' Winning run in Heats 5—7, with two 5-1s and a 4-2, and the hero in that respect was Danyon Hume who took a stunning win over Masters in Heat 6 and then came into the next race when Ben Basso broke the tapes, and promptly won that one as well with Ostergaard completing a shock maximum over Pickering.

Ostergaard and Basso then put he visitors 14 points to the good at the expense of Masters in Heat 10, and Cook neutralised the pairing of the Monarchs top two with the tactical substitute in play In the next, which all but confirmed victory.

Cook's first defeat came in Heat 13 but this time it was Tom Brennan up of Masters, and late wins for Kyle Thomson and Masters - after two from Paco Castagna - were limited consolation for the defeated hosts.

After Glasgow had dominated at Edinburgh 48 hours earlier, you would have got long odds on a last-heat decider at Ashfield, but that was exactly what happened as the Monarchs fought back strongly.

Sam Masters was sensational with an 18-point maximum, supported strongly by Josh Pickering and Kye Thomson, and had the visitors not been without reserve James Sarjeant whose partner had gone in labour, they may have been celebrating a famous victory.

As it was, Glasgow hold on without being at their best, just doing enough to hold back an Edinburgh charge which saw the win six of the last seven races,

The visitors were unlucky to see Lasse Fredriksen disqualified in Heat 1 for a hotly contested tapes offence, and they slipped six points behind to a 5-1 in the reserve race and a great ride by Benjamin Basso to pass Thomson in Heat 3.

The gap went up to 12 points thanks to Danyon Hume and Connor Bailey in Heat 8, but the fightback started in the next race with Masters taking a tactical substitute ride, as he and Pickering raced clear of Basso and Ulrich Ostergaard.

Thomson served notice of the Monarchs' improvement by holding back Craig Cook in Heat 10, and Masters was then involved in 4-2s in two of the next three races to reduce the arrears to just four points.

Basso and Bailey rescued a share from Heat 14 after the visitors gated, with Basso just failing to catch Thomson, and that left Edinburgh needing a 5-1 from the last race to draw.

That may have been half-expected given the way the momentum had swung, but whilst Masters gated to complete his full house, Cook used his experience to keep Pickering at bay and steer Glasgow to a narrow victory.

THIS second leg always promised a dramatic story either way, especially with the back - story of the Monarchs travelling without their top two due to a Polish fixture clash, and fighting tooth and nail to defend a 16-point lead.

But the stories that emerged were really at the top and bottom of the Glasgow riding order, as Craig Cook endured a mechanical nightmare which saw him fail to finish his first three rides, whilst Broc Nicol scored a four-ride paid maximum at reserve leaving home fans questioning his non-inclusion in Heat 14.

Cook suffered a clutch failure in Heat 1, a snapped chain in Heat 6, and a blown engine when leading Heat 10, handling the Monarchs a 5-1 from Kye Thomson and Paco Castagna which served to cancel out a similar result from Connor Bailey and Nicol two races earlier.

That meant with five races remaining Edinburgh had a ten-point aggregate lead intact, with Richard Lawson and Justin Sedgman doing enough to cover Sam Masters and Josh Pickering - Sedgman winning Heats 6 and 9 after conceding a 5-1 in Heat 4.

No change in Heat 11 as Lawson and Dillion Ruml packed in behind Tom Brennan, but Glasgow were given a glimmer of hope when Kye Thomson crashed out in Heat 12, thankfully avoiding serious injury, and after lengthy delay for fence repairs, Nicol and Ulrich Ostergaard completed a 5-1 in the re-run.

And when Cook, on his second bike, teamed up with Brennan for a 5-1 over the Monarchs' guests in Heat 13, the aggregate gap was down to two, and all momentum appeared to be with Glasgow.

Tigers fans will continue to debate the absence of Nicol from Heat 14, although it wouldn't have immediately been clear which rider to replace as Benjamin Basso had scored only three points beforehand but did win the race whilst Danyon Hume, with wins in Heats 2 and 7, was left at the back as a 3-3 resulted.

So all outcomes were possible ahead of Heat 15, and three laps in it looked like an aggregate tie and Golden Heats to decide it after Cook passed Lawson to lead, whilst the previously unbeaten Brennan held third place.

But this derby classic had one final twist in the tale with Sedgman, a man sacked by the Tigers late last season, coming back to haunt them by moving inside Brennan on the second bend of lap four to send another of his former clubs delightedly into the semi-finals.

The Scorpions limited the threat of Tigers No.1 Craig Cook to one win out of six, and took advantage of shortcomings elsewhere for the visitors, especially in the early stages, to triumph in a highly entertaining fixture.

OXFORD snatched victory from the jaws of defeat in a classic last heat decider to deny visiting Glasgow an away win. The Cheetahs took the lead for the one and only time when it mattered most as the chequered flag fell on the final race. With little to choose between the teams, a big Cowley crowd had been treated to a very tight contest throughout. The home side had the edge at the top end where guest No. 1 Chris Harris, comeback man Aaron Summers and Troy Batchelor won nine of the 16 races between them, but Glasgow's strength-in-depth counteracted that as the Tigers had only four non-scoring rides all night. It led to a total of 10 races being shared 3-3, seven of them coming in succession in mid- meeting between Heats 6 and 12. Oxford had fallen behind early, Glasgow seizing the initiative with 4-2s in the opening two races as first Harris and then debutant reserve Luke Killeen failed to complete four laps. There was a 15-minute hold up after a nasty first corner crash in Heat 4 following a collision between Killeen and Broc Nicol, for which the Cheetahs' youngster was excluded, but Batchelor easily won the re-run and Oxford levelled the scores with a Summers/Cameron Heeps 5-1 after Tigers top man Craig Cook had spun out on the third bend. Nicol was in the wars again in Heat 8, going down with Dillon Ruml at the first bend, but referee Willie Dishington ruled all four back. An emerging pattern of Oxford providing the first man home and the Tigers filling the minor places continued in the re-run as Summers took the flag for a third time, and was followed home by Danyon Hume and Nicol. Cook ended the sequence with a vital win in Heat 11 but again the race was shared, and the outstanding Hume, undoubtedly the man of the match, came up with a big three points for Glasgow in the next to keep the scores level for an eighth consecutive race. Tigers finally broke the deadlock with a 4-2 in Heat 13 from Cook and Tom Brennan and seemed on course for Victory when Hume led a 4-2 in the penultimate heat - only for Ruml to sneak past the visiting No.6 off the last corner. It would prove crucial in the final reckoning. Batchelor muscled Cook out around the opening bends of Heat 15 and Harris capitalised surge into second, the home pairing then team riding their way to a match-winning 5-1 despite the ever-pressing Cook's desperate efforts to find a way past.

POOLE racer Richard Lawson roared to 13 paid 14 points as Pirates got back on form with a 51-39 triumph over Glasgow to enhance their SGB Championship top-two chances.

Basso tallied five paid six points and received a mixed reception on the night he returned to Wimborne Road following his controversial switch to Ashfield over the winter.

Pirates' class of 2022 took the fight to the Tigers as Kemp led Ben Cook to a 4-2 in race eight, only for Glasgow to hit back with a maximum from Brennan and Craig Cook in Heat 9.

But Ben Cook and Lawson responded in kind in race 11, before a match-winning 5-1 from Lawson and Worrall over Craig Cook and Brennan in Heat 13 put Poole 10 points clear with tow heats to race.

GLASGOW moved back into CJL ascendancy by repeating the feat of Edinburgh one week earlier in coming from behind to win at Berwick. The Bandits had lost a ten-point lead with five races remaining against the Monarchs, and history effectively repeated itself hear as they led 30-27 after Heat 10 and then conceded three 5-1s in the next four races.

If that was charity on-track, there had been plenty off-track as well with the home promotion magnanimously agreeing to delay the start in order to allow Benjamin Basso to get to the track after suffering flight delays.

The Dane would play a big part his side's victory and won the re-run of Heat 3, having been adrift in the initial running when team-mate Ulrich Ostergaard fell on the third bend causing Jye Etheridge to also come to grief.

Ostergaard recovered to split Ricky Wells and Etheridge on the run to the line in Heat 5 to prevent a Berwick 5-1, and it was level after eight races before an unusual 3-0 result in Heat 9.

The Bandits appeared set for a 5-1, only for mechanical failure to send Etheridge into the fence and with Connor Bailey having already retired, that meant a two-man re-run - which became one when Tom Brennan fell due to a blown engine, leaving Ricky Wells as the only finisher.

But after a trademark pass by Chris Harris on Ostergaard in Heat 10, with Basso salvaging third place at the expense Theo Pijper, the Tigers turned the meeting as Hume and Basso out-trapped Leon Flint in Heat 11, with Ostergaard and Broc Nicol making it back-to-back maximums in the next.

Brennan rode superbly to defeat Harris in a shared Heat 13, enabling Basso and Nicol to wrap things up at the expense of Wells in the penultimate race before Harris and Flint knocked the Tigers down from four group points to three with a 5-1 in the last.

The result put Glasgow back in the driving seat in the group, whilst the Bandits continue to struggle at home. The absence of Jonas Knudsen due to his continued visa delay was clearly a major factor in the result.

EVEN a career-best equalling paid 17 from Jordan Jenkins was not enough to prevent injury-jinxed Glasgow from snatching the points and sealing an automatic place in the play-off semi finals at the end of a dramatic encounter on Teesside.

The Tigers, already without inform Benjamin Basso (shoulder) and former Bears favourite Ulrich Ostergaard (hand), welcomed back number one Craig Cook but, slotting straight back into the groove with four straight wins, the former Champion was forced to withdraw after being inadvertently taken out by Charles Wright in a high speed Heat 13 crash.

Cook and Aaron Summers another ex-Redcar racer who proved an astute choice of guest for Ostergaard - got the visitors away to a perfect start with maximum points in Heat 1 as the Tigers led for most of the match.

Redcar edged ahead for one race through a Lewis Kerr/Jenkins 5-1 in Heat 4 but the Scottish outfit, with Cook, Summers and temporary skipper Tom Brennan looking especially quick, extended their lead up to ten points through successive race advantages from Heats 5 to 9. Brennan came down heavily trying to pass Bears' guest Danny King in the first staging of Heat 9, and the home side took advantage with consecutive 5-1s to close the gap to just two.

More controversy followed in Heat 11 as Kerr was adjudged to have taken out his own team-mate Kyle Newman yet, having spent five minutes being attended to by medics on the track and with the ambulance ready to pick up Bears recent signing, the Poole-based rider limped back to the pits and bravely gave Cook plenty to think about while resisting the challenge of Summers in the re-run.

King was joined by Jenkins at the front to tie the scores in Heat 12 before Wright picked up unexpected drive and took Cook out into the back straight fence on the opening lap of the next race.

After much deliberation the Glasgow man was withdrawn on medical advice, displaying signs of concussion, as Jenkins stormed through from the back to join an already battered and bruised Andersen and put Redcar back in front with one decisive race to go.

Fast-starting Brennan hit the front and Kerr was unable to fend off a flying Summers who sealed only Redcar's second home defeat of the year, to the dismay of most of a sizeable Sunday crowd and, no doubt to the delight of fellow play-off aspirants Scunthorpe, who visit Teesside on Friday.

Jenkins' sparkling 15+2 was his highest score in Bears' colours as Kerr, despite his fourth ride exclusion, weighed in with 11, while Brennan (13), Cook (12) and Summers (11+3) all collected double figures for the Tigers.

FROM the rain to the pain.
 Just seven days earlier, it had been the weather that had caused so much controversy between the clubs.

PLYMOUTH climbed to fourth place in the final Championship standings by winning this delayed encounter between two patched-up sides at the Coliseum.

The Gladiators' guests came trumps with Richie Worrall racing to a six-ride paid maximum and James Wright adding three wins and a paid win himself - and with skipper Hans Andersen also in form, it was a comfortable home victory despite the Tigers taking an early lead with 5-1 in Heat 2.

The visitors were restricted to three race wins and the rider replacement facility for Ulrich Ostergaard accrued just three points, whilst Craig Cook was a non-appearance due to a reported breakdown on route, with Dillon Ruml appearing as a 'no facility' guest but failing to trouble the scorers.

Two 5-1s involving Wright took the Gladiators clear by Heat 5, the latter seeing him fend off the attentions of Benjamin Basso, and Paul Starke came the closest to defeating Worrall when he led him for three and a half laps of Heat 6.

The Tigers kept in touch until the closing stages, but back-to-back 5-1s in Heats 13 and 14 ensured they would leave point-less as Andersen and Worrall overcame Basso and Tom Brennan in the first of those.

There was a somewhat bizarre end to the meeting when Worrall was credited with a new track record of 49.39 in the final race - 1.5s quicker than any other time on the night - but video replays suggested the time was, in fact around the 52s mark, far more in keeping with the others clocked at that stage of proceedings rather than one which was 0.01s inside the existing record.
