There has been some question as to whether this was a dirt track (speedway) or a grass track. Read on for the answer. Other meetings may have been staged at this venue in 1928.

"The committee of the Pirates Motor Racing Club had not been informed that the police had objected to the meeting on Sunday 29th July. A letter from the police said it was impossible to give assistance and the meeting must be abandoned. A meeting would not be held on Sunday 5th August, but the other meetings arranged for Bank Holiday Monday and Tuesday would be run off in the ordinary way."

4,000. Opening meeting.

"A cloud of dust and they were away, ploughing a precarious course along a loosely cindered track. That was how the riders on the new motor cycle dirt track at the Northampton Speedway Ground, Hannington, went on Bank Holiday" J N White set a track record of 84.4 secs – "the course, which was over 440 yards round, had to be lapped 4 times".

"The most exciting race was, however, not on the dirt track but on the grass. It was a match between Reg Tuckley and J M White, over 4 laps of a course measuring one-third of a mile. Tuckley ... beat White by 8 yds. Several times White nearly passed his opponent, but the corners were not long enough!" Arthur Jervis absent due to injury, Digger Pugh absent because his machine did not arrive. "Some of the machines did not strictly conform to the stated programmed cc"
