Tuesday 5 June 1928

Although there were many engine problems in this meeting, this was nevertheless a fine night's racing. Lamont suffered most, riding an AJS, then a Harley, and finally a Douglas; whilst Roger Frogley's Rudge was damaged when he suddenly slowed during a heat of the Pennant and was hit by Charlie Spinks. Frogley then borrowed Reg Pointer's Ariel.

In the Silver Pennant Final, four Australians (Lamont, Huxley, Arthur, and Spinks) produced a spectacular race until, at the start of the last lap, "Huxley's chain and seat stays suddenly twisted to a corkscrew, and his back wheel went almost at right angles to the rest of the machine", and he was just missed by Lamont. At the front, Arthur passed Spinks for the lead, but then Charlie fell and Lamont, right behind him, somehow avoided the carnage before his motor died and he pushed home for second place.

Englishman Eric Spencer was the star at a packed Harringay, coming a close second to Huxley in the Silver Wheel after winning the handicap event.

Dicky Smythe reduced Huxley's lap record by a tenth of a second to 21.9 sec.

Highlight was a sensational Gold Helmet Final when Lamont, on the outside, and Huxley, inside, were together throughout the four laps, never separated by more than half a bike length, before Lamont won by half a wheel. Then Huxley, on Eric Spencer's Douglas, lowered the lap record to 21.3 sec.
