PETERBOROUGH made a seamless transition into 2022 as they controlled an entertaining fixture where Ipswich came up short despite plenty of effort.

It only took a couple of rides for new signing Benjamin Basso to become a crowd favourite, as he not only won Heat 2 but then took a series of higher Witches scalps, none more so than former World Champion Jason Doyle.

That came in a dramatic Heat 11 when the impressive Erik Riss took a tactical ride for the visitors, only for Basso and an outstanding Chris Harris to foil their every move and record what was essentially a match-clinching 5—1 for the Panthers.

Michael Palm Toft and Scott spent much of last season at Nos. 3 and 4, but as a new opening combination they both came from the back for 5-1's in Heats 1 and 6, with Nicholls forcing inside Danny King in the latter to create space for Palm Toft - and MPT then went from third to first past Riss and Troy Batchelor in Heat 10.

Doyle took a race win in his second outing but was also relegated to the back in Heat 13 thanks to a last-bend move by Palm Toft, and the Witches will feel there's plenty more to come in several areas.

But for the Panthers it was business as usual, with the exception of Hans Andersen who looked down on power and endured a rare scoreless night - making the team's 53-point total even more impressive.

It might be a new season but there was an air of familiarity about the outcome as Peterborough continued their recent domination of this fixture with an impressive away win.  
 Jason Doyle won four races on his home debut for Ipswich but the strength-in-depth was with the Panthers, for whom Hans Andersen made a spectacular return to form after failing to score in the reverse match.  
 Andersen and Ulrich Ostergaard combined for two 5-15 and the lead was up to eight points when Michael Palm Toft passed Danny King in Heat 11 — and then Doyle crashed out when taking a tactical substitute ride in the next.  
 Palm Toft and Chris Harris shared the points in Heat 13 to secure the win, although Andersen was denied a maximum after a fierce battle with Doyle in Heat 15, with the Australian eventually coming through on the third lap.

WHAT a difference a year makes — as King's Lynn, rock bottom throughout 2021, have booked their place in the League Cup Final and have already exceeded the number of wins they managed through the whole of last season.

There are several reasons for that huge improvement, but the biggest one of them is called Josh Pickering, as the Australian secured a memorable maximum which saw him take on and beat Jason Doyle from the back.

Ipswich were largely on a hiding to nothing with their lower order decimated by injury and illness, and after holding things level after Heat 4 they conceded 5—1s in Heats 5 and 8 to go eight points down.

Doyle took a tactical substitute ride In Heat 9 and was paired with the unbeaten Danny King - but Pickering won a thriller with Lewis Kerr third to virtually break the Witches' resistance.

The home side marched on with 5-1s in Heats 13 and 14 to underline their all—round strength, with Richie Worrall paid for double figures at reserve, and Pickering sealed the full house he deserved at the expense of Doyle and Troy Batchelor in the last race.

FOUR last heat deciders and four victories for King's Lynn, who completed a terrific League Cup group campaign with clear daylight at the top of the table.

The team-building model to start with Richie Worrall at reserve continues to pay dividends, with the Stars achieving this result even with big-hitters Josh Pickering and Richard Lawson scoring just seven points between them.

In fairness to the Witches, they were hampered by the absence of reserve duo Paul Starke and Anders Rowe due to illness, and had they been present the result may well have been different.

As it was, the Jason Doyle/Erik Riss combination picked up two 5-1s, but the Stars also had two maximums in the first six races, and it was they who took control with Worrall and Pickering outriding Troy Batchelor and Cameron Heeps in Heat 14.

Ipswich levelled with two 4-25 but trailed two points going into Heat 13, which as shared with Doyle passing Pickering from the handicap after breaking the tapes.

That remained the case as the Stars also shared Heat 14 with Jack Thomas completing an impressive display - and although Doyle notched his fourth win in the decider, Worrall and Iversen finished clear of Danny King to win it for the visitors.

IPSWICH enjoyed the relief of an opening league win after their disappointing Foxhall form in 2021 had threatened to carry over into the new campaign.

Troy Batchelor was key to the victory as he opened up with three race wins, whilst Jason Doyle rode through the pain barrier of a perforated eardrum and still picked up three victories of his own.

Matej Zagar was the Aces' only winner in the first seven races, by which time they found themselves eight points down, after Max Fricke suffered a pair of uncharacteristic last places.

But Zagar and Brady Kurtz romped to a 5-1 over Dany King in Heat 9 to make the match far more interesting — only for the Slovenian to miss out completely in Heat 12 as King took the flag whilst Paul Starke crucially got the better of Tom Brennan.

The Witches should have had a 5-1 in Heat 13 only for Batchelor to drop to the back, and that left the door open for the Aces to snatch league point - which they achieved courtesy of Kurtz and Zagar with Doyle not racing in Heat 15.

IPSWICH have been the great escapologists of 2022 - but quite how they rescued victory from an eight-point deficit with five races remaining takes a good deal of explaining, especially as far as beaten local rivals King's Lynn were concerned. It was the fourth time this season that the Witches have triumphed at Foxhall in either a last-heat decider or a Super Heat, and once again the massive added value of Jason Doyle to their side this year was in full evidence. But for the Stars, it was the story of their season — and certainly the last week, as for the third match running, they let a winning position slip, and after potentially having at least six league points within range at Sheffield and Ipswich they came away with just two. Witches boss Ritchie Hawkins felt it was the visitors who were the hungrier side in the first 10 races, and certainly they looked likely winners as they led 34-26 even with No.1 Josh Pickering suffering mechanical trouble and only scoring one point. Frederik Jakobsen had exactly the impact the Stars wanted at reserve, Richie Worrall also won his first two rides, and with others chipping in they established a position of control, thanks especially to a Worrall/Klindt 5-1 in Heat 7 which was immediately backed up by a 4-2 from Thomas Jorgensen and Jason Edwards in the next. The tactical substitute race in Heat 11 did change things as Pickering came to grief under pressure from Troy Batchelor, which also caused Jorgensen to come down, and in the re-run Doyle and Batchelor raced to a 5-1 over the Dane. But King's Lynn did their jobs in Heats 12 and 13, following Danny King and Doyle home for shared races, and would have hoped to clinch victory in Heat 14 when they paired their new signings. In fact, though, it was the Witches' new recruits who triumphed but only after Klindt had been penalised 15 metres for not being ready to race upon the expiry of the time limit. Aaron Summers and Rohan Tungate then delighted the home crowd by switching inside Jakobsen off turn two for a 5-1 to level the scores. Momentum was now with the home side although the Stars had gate choice for Heat 15 — but Doyle made it from gate two, leaving a battle for the minor places with Tungate overcoming Worrall for third place despite the efforts of Lawson to work an opening for his partner, which generated a little post-race discussion. The result means Ipswich officially need just one more point to clinch their play-off place - but more realistically, this was almost certainly the night where the top-four qualifiers were all-but secured with King's Lynn and Peterborough now surely too far adrift.

THIS was the fourth time this season Ipswich had been held to a 46-44 home win — and given the depleted Peterborough line-up, surely the most unexpected.

But given that seven of the Witches' ten home fixtures have ended with a maximum of four points between the sides, and also the way in which the Panthers performed in similar circumstances at King's Lynn one week earlier, maybe it shouldn't have come as a total surprise. And their lack of domination at Foxhall must present the Witches with some concern ahead of the play-offs, although it should also be said that their own away form has been generally strong.

WITH Ipswich 9-3 up after two races, seemingly heading for a 4-2 in Heat 3, and Belle Vue being without their No.1 due to injury, everything was set up for the Witches to build a sizable advantage to take to Manchester.

But what happened next ranks as one of the biggest disasters in play-off history, at least if you were supporting the home side, whilst for the Aces it was arguably their performance of the season - and one which even exceeded a similar showing at Sheffield at the same stage last year.

The third bend of the third lap of the third race proved crucial as Matej Zagar, who had overcome Danny King for second place, steamed inside Rohan Tungate, and the Australian slid off under the lightest of contact. Referee Mick Bates deemed the move to be fair, Aces were awarded a 4-2 and the contest changed completely.

True, Ipswich did maintain a narrow advantage on the night until the midway stage, by which time it already appeared clear that Jason Doyle would be in unbeatable form, but the cracks were beginning to appear elsewhere and Tungate in particular endured a nightmare meeting. And catalogue of catastrophe between Heats 5 and 12 left the home side stunned. First, Tom Brennan and Nick Blodorn gated on a 5-1 in the eighth, and on the back straight Witches duo Anders Rowe and Aaron Summers contrived to collide with each other, knocking a chain off for Summers and forcing Rowe to limp home for third place.

Tungate was a retirement early in Heat 9 as the Aces went four points up, and worse followed in Heat 11 with Troy Batchelor set for a race win over Brennan and guest Craig Cook, only to pack up himself with half a lap remaining.

That turned a 3-3 into a 1-5 and there was more to come when King fell on turn four of Heat 12 shortly after being overhauled by Zagar, who duly teamed up with the most impressive Blodorn in the re-run.

Ipswich did gain a 4-2 from Heat 13 after Cook spun and fell spectacularly on turn one, but Blodorn showed great maturity to overcome Tungate in Heat 14 for another Belle Vue 5-1 along with Charles Wright.

Doyle duly completed his maximum in the last race but both Zagar and the Aces' impressive skipper Brady Kurtz quickly reversed Batchelor to the back to complete a near-perfect night's work - and whilst the Witches have seen the warning signs at home on so many occasions this year their major implosion came at the worst possible time.

AFTER a screechin', smokin' u-turn, fast Lambo arrived in Manchester to put the skids under Ipswich's title hopes. It had been the most dramatic 48 hours of the season following on from Robert Lambert declaring on Twitter that he had signed for Belle Vue only for the BSPL to block his move to the National Speedway Stadium. Cue an avalanche of opinions, the new World No.5 had lit the firework. But on Monday morning at precisely 10am, it was confirmed he was cleared to ride. And boy was he worth the wait. The APTI Aces were all but home and hosed in this tie after their 14-point win at Foxhall. But Mark Lemon's second signing masterstroke of the season had everyone licking their lips over Lambo. Any lingering positivity Ipswich fans had over a miracle comeback were soon dashed as the home side reeled off four opening wins to effectively kill the semi-final. In truth, the Witches failed to brew up even a spell of brilliance. Jason Doyle sweetly swept by Matej Zagar in Heat 5 to nail their first heat win. Troy Batchelor won the next but then it was all one-way traffic with Lambo leading the way. Tom Brennan and Charles Wright came to life to win Heats 8 and 9 while Brady Kurtz extended the home side's lead to 12 points in the next. The scene was set for a fitting finale. Lambert reeled off his win in front of a slightly subdued Doyle and that was enough to confirm the aggregate win. In Heat 13 Doyle made a clinical start but it was a Rambo Lambo robust burst to charge under the Aussie for another win. Wright roared clear in the next and then the race of the night to round it off. Doyle again surged from the tapes but Zagar and Lambert were all over him in a flash. Lambert shot through a gap between the pair and then after exchanging places twice, Zagar made it stick for a final maximum. Lambert got the bumps for a barnstorming debut 15-point max and the APTI Aces are in the Grand Final for a second successive year. Ipswich's scoring was dominated by Jason Doyle, who won his first three rides before losing out to Masters and Holder, and the Witches' sole advantage came the last as Doyle combined with Danny King for a consolation 5-1. By then, though, the win was well in the bag for Sheffield, who secured back-to-back 5-1s in Heats 3 and 4 with King breaking the in the former, and an unhappy Troy Batchelor conceding maximum points on his old home track in the latter, and that was also the case in Heat 6 when he was passed by guest team-mate Lee Complin before retiring. Doyle replaced Batchelor to win a tactical substitute ride in Heat 9, and King split Holder and Lewis Kerr with a brave move in Heat 10 before taking a win over Adam Ellis in Heat 12 in an on-the-line decision. There were wins for Holder and Ellis in the next two races, both of which ended in Sheffield 4-2s, before the visitors took their last-race maximum. The Witches finish second in the table, three points behind the Tigers and five ahead of champions Belle Vue — who knocked out both of the sides above them in the play-offs.
