KENT took advantage of a succession of first-night problems for Plymouth to put four NDL points on the board from the first meeting of their new era.

The first 10 races could hardly have gone worse for the Centurions with Ben Trigger falling in Heat 2 whilst chasing Chris Watts, and Henry Atkins coming to grief in Heat 4 as he attempted to split the Royals.

Both races were 5-1s to the visitors, and a third maximum followed in Heat 7 when race leader Atkins ground to a halt as his race-jacket dislodged his cut-out.

And then in Heat 8 there was a spectacular first-bend incident when Sam Woolley tangled with Trigger, bringing the Plymouth rider down heavily, before home man Richard Andrews lost a chain in Heat 9, and Connor King was withdrawn after crashing in the next.

But that catalogue of disaster shouldn't detract from a great night for the Royals, who were led by heat leaders Alfie Bowtell and Ben Morley and also included a fine display from Joe Alcock to reach double figures.

There was at least some relief for Plymouth in Heat 15 when their regular Championship duo, Bowtell and Dan Gilkes, came to grief after Bowtell misjudged his attempted overtake, with both thankfully walking away.

MILDENHALL went through after a nail-biting encounter which went to a last-race decider where a 5-1 to the Royals would have set up a Golden Heats showdown.

In the event, there was frustration for the hosts when the previously unbeaten Alfie Bowtell was disqualified having failed to beat the two-minute time allowance, with Jason Edwards and Ryan Kinsley recording a 4-2 for the Fen Tigers to take them into the Final by a six-point aggregate margin.

Bowtell had earlier lowered the lward track record by half a second, but the Royals' early advantage was checked by back- to-back Mildenhall advantages mid- meeting to regain their 12-point aggregate lead.

Kent chipped away and grabbed a 5-1 in Heat 10 from Bowtell and Jamie Halder over the previously unbeaten Jack Kingston, and they got the gap down to six thanks to a 4-2 from Bowtell and Ben Morley in Heat 13.

There was drama in Heat 14 when the Royals' Joe Alcock came down as Alex Spooner locked up, with the Mildenhall man disqualified. Kent were awarded a 4—2, but it wasn't enough, with the visitors indebted to reserve Josh Warren with a career-best 11+1 from five rides.

Bowtell broke his own track record by 0.4 of a second in Heat 1 and proceeded to defeat opposite number Dan Thompson on two further occasions, despite a big effort from the Lion Cubs youngster in the latter heats.

Back-up for the Royals came from Ben Morley, who won his opening two rides, and combined with Bowtell for a big 5-1 in Heat 13 after Joe Thompson had come to grief - and from Joe Alcock, who recovered superbly from a fall in his first ride to post three straight wins.

The Lion Cubs suffered a blow when youngster Max Perry clipped Chris Watts in Heat 2 and was withdrawn with a broken collarbone.

Colleague Vinnie Foord won that race and had to take seven rides throughout the meeting as he covered Perry's rides.

Leicester were within two points with three races remaining, but the Bowtell/Morley 5-1 over Dan Thompson extended the gap, and two 4-2s followed to wrap up a successful showing from the hosts.
