Why, I even remember him pipping Roger Frogley on the last turn on one occasion by turning in his saddle and making a rude gesture. I have yet to see harm come from "turning round" and I doubt if I ever shall."

The visitors led 22-20 after 7 heats of the league match, but Lea Bridge took a surprise 5-1 with an excellent ride from Spinks and Foulds over Frank Arthur in heat 8 to give the home team a two-point lead. In the final race, Lea Bridge took a 3-3 to secure the victory – or thought they had, but the Steward decided to exclude Jimmy Stevens for “bumping” Colin Ford. Osment then protested that he had been “bumped” by Ford, but this was not upheld, and an angry crowd had to be content with a draw. In the handicap final, Harry Mangham (NZ) broke his collarbone when he laid his bike down to avoid the fallen Charlie Jackson.
