AS Poole supporters paid tribute to one of their most loyal servants, they also enjoyed a glimpse of what may well be set to follow from the younger brigade in the 2022 season.

The Pirates' heat leader strength is well documented but the back-up from the Cook brothers will be all-important, and both Zach and Ben turned in impressive displays in this meeting with reserve Drew Kemp winning two races after running a last in Heat 2.

On the face of it, this was Championship winners defeating Premiership winners, although the Peterborough side wasn't at its usual strength and Michael Palm Toft at No.1 suffered three last places along with a Heat 5 win.

Two 5-1s to the visitors levelled the scores after Heat 6 with Jordan Palin defeating Steve Worrall in the latter, but the Pirates took the next four races by a 19-5 margin with Cook brothers getting the better of Hans Andersen Heat 8.

Andersen and Scott Nicholls offered most threat for the Panthers, but a 5-1 from Danny King and Zach Cook over Ulrich Ostergaard in Heat 12 ensured the Pirates won on the night.

Heat 13 was designated the Gordon Day memorial race, and it was Nicholls who took the memento trophy in a nice touch by Pedersen to pay tribute to such a hugely respected administrator.

PETERBOROUGH made a seamless transition into 2022 as they controlled an entertaining fixture where Ipswich came up short despite plenty of effort. It only took a couple of rides for new signing Benjamin Basso to become a crowd favourite, as he not only won Heat 2 but then took a series of higher Witches scalps, none more so than former World Champion Jason Doyle. That came in a dramatic Heat 11 when the impressive Erik Riss took a tactical ride for the visitors, only for Basso and an outstanding Chris Harris to foil their every move and record what was essentially a match-clinching 5—1 for the Panthers. Michael Palm Toft and Scott spent much of last season at Nos. 3 and 4, but as a new opening combination they both came from the back for 5-1's in Heats 1 and 6, with Nicholls forcing inside Danny King in the latter to create space for Palm Toft - and MPT then went from third to first past Riss and Troy Batchelor in Heat 10. Doyle took a race win in his second outing but was also relegated to the back in Heat 13 thanks to a last-bend move by Palm Toft, and the Witches will feel there's plenty more to come in several areas. But for the Panthers it was business as usual, with the exception of Hans Andersen who looked down on power and endured a rare scoreless night - making the team's 53-point total even more impressive.

Jason Doyle won four races on his home debut for Ipswich but the strength-in-depth was with the Panthers, for whom Hans Andersen made a spectacular return to form after failing to score in the reverse match.

Andersen and Ulrich Ostergaard combined for two 5-15 and the lead was up to eight points when Michael Palm Toft passed Danny King in Heat 11 — and then Doyle crashed out when taking a tactical substitute ride in the next.

Palm Toft and Chris Harris shared the points in Heat 13 to secure the win, although Andersen was denied a maximum after a fierce battle with Doyle in Heat 15, with the Australian eventually coming through on the third lap.

But the Stars regrouped with Josh Pickering, Iversen and Richie Worrall all winning races, and Iversen then took control of the decider as Chris Harris just edged out the all-action Pickering for second place to prevent them taking all four points.

Josh Pickering and Niels-Kristian Iversen combined for a brilliant Heat 15 5-1 to win the meeting for Lynn and bring the feel-good factor back to the Adrian Flux Arena.

The Stars completed the double over the Panthers to take control of the southern League Cup group, but the meeting went right down to the wire after influential reserve Benjamin Basso won Heat 14 with team-mate Hans Andersen completing a 5-1 to level the scores.

And the Panthers looked to have engineered a winning position in the decider through Chris Harris and Ulrich Ostergaard — only for Pickering to open things up with a dramatic move, and for Iversen to take advantage and also come from the back.

It was viewed by many as one of the best races at the venue in years, and it was enough for Lynn to see off a stern Panthers challenge even though the visitors only had three riders in the major points.

Ostergaard won his first three rides and Harris also took the flag on three occasions, missing out in Heat 9 as Pickering and Kerr took the second of their 5-1s as a combination.

That levelled things up after Basso had been involved in two advantages to put the Panthers four points to the good, and the crucial move looked to have come in Heat 12 when Pickering re-passed Ostergaard for second place behind team-mate Richie Worrall.

But the Panthers were handed a lifeline when Richard Lawson was disqualified from Heat 13, enabling Scott Nicholls to take a point, and then Kerr broke the tapes in Heat 14.

At 42-42, the Stars had a choice to make for the decider as Iversen had suffered a heavy Heat 1 crash with Ostergaard, but he was able to raise himself for the finale alongside Pickering as the side were left celebrating in a tremendous conclusion.

NOBODY saw this result coming - least of all the two clubs involved, as Belle Vue ran riot and champions Peterborough suffered a thumping defeat.

All the pre-meeting talk was of the return of Matej Zagar to the Aces, and the Slovenian duly delivered a typically swashbuckling performance, but others who struggled during their League Cup campaign stepped up to the plate whilst the Panthers subsided. The visitors conceded four 5-1s to start the meeting — although the verdict Charles Wright gained over Ulrich Ostergaard in Heat 3 could have gone the other way — and there were also four Peterborough retirements in the first five races.

THE League Cup campaign must seem a world away for Belle Vue, who have taken eight points from three Premiership matches and shown huge potential for another title challenge

The most striking aspect of this romp at Peterborough - the venue where their Grand Final hopes ended in despair last October — was the fact they racked up 54 points even with heat leader duo Mex Fricke and Matej Zagar both some way short of double figures.

That's not to say that neither contributed to the victory, as Fricke shared in two 5-1's, but it was skipper Brady Kurtz who took top billing with his second maximum against the Panthers, and he appears to have raised the bar this season.

The writing was on the wall for the reigning champions when they conceded three 5-1's in the first five races, with Aces' reserves Norick Blodorn and Tom Brennan both fully involved, whilst the visiting riders bundled their way past Ulrich Ostergaard for a share in Heat 3 after a good start by the Dane.

Belle Vue recorded advantages throughout Heats 4-9 with Michael Palm Toft lifting on turn two in Heat 6 and dropping to the back after making the start - and the meeting was all over when a scoreless Ostergaard and Hans Andersen conceded maximum points to Blodorn and Kurtz in Heat 9.

The Panthers did manage to save some face in the closing stages, although a 5-1 was lost in Heat 10 when Charles Wright and Zagar passed Scott Nicholls, and they gained some encouragement again from the display of Benjamin Basso.

First, he shocked Fricke with a late move for third place in Heat 11, and then he combined with Palm Toft for a consolation 5-1 over Zagar in the next race.

But the Aces underlined their dominance over the closing stages with Fricke re-passing Palm Toft in a 5-1 with Kurtz in Heat 13, and Wright and Kurtz took control of the last two races to wrap up an eye-catching away win.

But then came the fightback with Doyle involved in all of the last three races, the first two of which ended in 4-2s as King and Tungate supplied the third places, and then Doyle and Tungate gated in Heat 15 to level the scores.

The Super Heat was a classic with Pickering making the start but the Witches holding the second and third places they needed, before Doyle went round Pickering, who was looking for Basso.

The Dane duly switched inside Tungate at the start of lap two and it was advantage Panthers, but Tungate fought back once more and charged down the inside heading into the last lap, with Basso going out wide and out of contention before Tungate put the icing on the cake by rounding Pickering on the final bend.

THIS was the fourth time this season Ipswich had been held to a 46-44 home win — and given the depleted Peterborough line-up, surely the most unexpected.

But given that seven of the Witches' ten home fixtures have ended with a maximum of four points between the sides, and also the way in which the Panthers performed in similar circumstances at King's Lynn one week earlier, maybe it shouldn't have come as a total surprise. And their lack of domination at Foxhall must present the Witches with some concern ahead of the play-offs, although it should also be said that their own away form has been generally strong.

It was Jason Doyle and Danny King who steered them home in what they will regard as an unnecessarily nervous last-heat decider, after the Panthers had come back from eight points down with five races remaining.

Chris Harris was on the receiving end of a 5-1 in Heat 1 against Doyle and Aaron Summers, but he quickly recovered and with support from another high-scoring display at reserve by Scott Nicolls and solid scoring from Benjamin Basso, the Panthers wouldn't be shaken off.

The home side did look to be taking control with a 5-1 from King and Rohan Tungate over Nicholls in Heat 9, and with Nicholls missing the time allowance for Heat 10 a further 4-2 put the Witches 34-26 ahead.

But there was a shock in Heat 11 with Drew Kemp going past Troy Bachelor to team Harris for a 5-1, although the Witches went back to six ahead with Anders Rowe clearing Simon Lambert for third place in Heat 12.

The 13th was shared with Doyle notching a fourth straight win whilst Harris and Basso packed the places, but a big finale was set up when Basso passed Cameron Heeps for second place behind Nicholls in Heat 14 with Tungate having missed out at the start.

However, a lack of fitness of Basso led to Kemp receiving the call for Heat 15, and although Doyle suffered a rare defeat in a decider as Harris took the race, the Ipswich pair did enough to get their side over the line with a 3-3.
