A SENSATIONAL display from Plymouth reserve Dan Gilkes wasn't quite enough to edge his side to a first-leg advantage from this quarter-final tie.

Gilkes won four races on his way to 16 points, and after beating both Steve Worrall and Danny King along the way, he then incredibly defeated both Pirates' big guns when he was called up for Heat 13.

However, there was no stopping Richard Lawson, who raced to a five-ride paid maximum on his return to the track where he had been expected to be a home star in 2022.

Plymouth led by six points after Heat 6 and appeared on course for a notable victory, but they were outgunned in the heat leader department and Edward Kennett was withdrawn with an aggravated arm injury.

The Pirates levelled with a 5-1 in Heat 10 after Lawson went down under Ben Barker's challenge, with the home rider disqualified.

And with the scores at 39-39, Gilkes was thrown out of Heat 14 for a second start-line offence, leading to a 4-2 which put Poole ahead — and Worrall and Lawson completed the job in the final race.

AFTER a tight encounter in the first leg, Poole's progression to the semi-finals was never under threat, and they can be expected to build another strong home record in 2022.
 The Pirates' only consistent threat came from Plymouth guest Chris Harris, who could well be set for several stand-in appearances for the Gladiators, with the former Poole man winning his first four rides.
 But in the period of the meeting where Harris was off-track, between Heats 6 and 10, the home side raced to four 5-1s and a 4-2 to put the tie totally beyond the visitors.
 And their second strings and reserves both showed their worth as Zach Cook re-passed Hans Andersen for a 5-1 with Steve Worrall in Heat 6, and Drew Kemp took the lead in the next as Danny King passed Michael Palm Toft for second spot.
 Andersen had won his opening ride, but he was then beaten by Ben Cook in Heat 9, and Zach re-passed Palm Toft in the next as both races ended in Poole maximums.

REDCAR took the win from an eventful and controversial meeting, but there was little doubt Plymouth deserved the league point they collected with a 5-1 in Heat 15.

There was talking points aplenty, not least an incident in Heat 4 when Erik Riss stormed under Dan Gilkes into turn three with the Gladiators more than unhappy to see Gilkes determined the cause of the collision and being disqualified.

A close battle between Lewis Kerr and Plymouth guest Chris Harris in Heat 5 saw the Bears man given the verdict on the line, but the Gladiators remained in touch and trailed by just two points when Hans Andersen won Heat 9 after Kerr had bike trouble.

But Harris was then disqualified from Heat 11 after his team-mate Gilkes took a heavy fall on the first bend, and although Ben Barker won the next race they were denied an advantage when tactical substitute Harris hit mechanical trouble in third place.

Redcar's points were safe thanks to a 5-1 from Riss and Charles Wright in Heat 13, but former Bears man Michael Palm Toft had the final say, winning Heat 14 and then teaming with Harris in the last race for a 5-1 which meant the Gladiators took something for their efforts.

BEN Barker turned on the style with an 18-point maximum as Plymouth recorded one of the stand-out results of the season so far by hitting 60 against much-fancied Leicester.

The Gladiators always looked to have a good guest in Richard Lawson replacing Edward Kennett, but Michael Palm Toft's Easter Monday crash left them using replacement and theoretically vulnerable - but they never gave the Lions a sniff.

An early trading of 5-1s included Alfie Bowtell holding off Nick Morris in Heat 1, and an early Leicester tactical substitute went horribly wrong when they conceded a 5-1 as Morris crashed out and Richie Worrall was headed by Dan Gilkes after a clash with Barker.

Bowell used the outside to good effect against Worrall in Heat 6 and to join Gilkes for a 5-1 in Heat 8, and Gilkes defeated Worrall in Heat 9 in the second of back-to-back maximums.

Gilkes' fellow reserve Henry Atkins was team-ridden by skipper Hans Andersen to a 5-1 over Morris in Heat 11, with three more 4-2s taking the Gladiators up to 60 with the impeccable Barker winning the last two races.

BOTH sides had something to take from the meeting after Scunthorpe produced a spirited comeback to collect a league point from an improbable position.
 The Scorpions were 14 points down after Heat 10, despite providing four race winners, with the Gladiators recording a 5-1 providing in Heat 4 when Jake Allen was overhauled by Dan Gilkes and then Hans Andersen — and there was another maximum in the tenth from Alfie Bowtell and guest Richard Lawson after Jordan Palin had come to grief.
 The home side's only real setback came in Heat 3 when Ben Barker was disqualified for putting both wheels over the inner line, and they seemed set for a convincing margin of victory.
 But Ryan Douglas rode in four of the last five races for Scunthorpe, Winning a tactical substitute outing ahead of Barker in Heat 12, and there were important points at reserve for Ryan Kinsley and Zaine Kennedy, the latter combining with Tero Aarnio for a 5-1 in Heat 14. And it was Aarnio who won the final race ahead of Lawson as he made the start from the outside, whilst Douglas contributed the vital third place by holding Andersen at bay.

That effectively put Plymouth into the entire contest with just four riders, and in the circumstances they did well to keep things as competitive as they did.

Fortunately, with Josh Pickering taking a guest booking and racing in nearly half of the heats, there was still plenty of entertainment as the Australian piled up 17 points, although he was upstaged by the home side's top two of Scott Nicholls and Troy Batchelor in Heat 13.

Nicholls scored a four-ride maximum and the home side will also have been encouraged by Paul Starke's best display since joining the club, and three wins in his first three rides for Cameron Heeps.

Guests James Wright and Jake Mulford also won races for the Gladiators, who ended the meeting with just one of their regular rides - and even Ben Morley himself was an injury replacement earlier in the season!

Fans of both teams will have been happy to see Danish racer Hans Andersen back on track after he was knocked out during Neil Middleditch's testimonial at Poole on August 31. He topped the Plymouth score chart on 10.

But with the visitors failing to register a single heat advantage and collecting only one race win, which saw Aaron Summers beat Zach Cook and Drew Kemp in race 14, the tie slipped away from them very quickly.

After earning a bye into the semi-finals by finishing top in 2021, Pirates were left kicking their heels for weeks while the quarter-finals were completed.

Racing the quarters in 2022 may prove to be a blessing as Pirates prepare for the likes of Leicester and Glasgow brimming with the confidence emphatic victory.
