It is difficult to single out one man for special mention, but it was undoubtedly Frank Johnson's match. He is easily the most improved of Dragons' riders and the fans were mad with joy as he proceeded to give his best-ever display on the Welsh track.

Southampton have one consolation for this mammoth National Trophy defeat. They never gave up trying, even when they were 40 points down. Only Croucher and Dud Smith won races for them, the latter doing particularly well to hold off Jimmy Wright and Hugh Geddes in Heat 3.

Bert Croucher's Heat 8 win was value for money too. He came from nearly last to a good first. Pugh shone for the home team, and is rapidly becoming one of the best men in the division.

Saints hopes of an aggregate win must be small. But 12,000 Dragons fans rate them a side of triers for all that.

Chum Taylor had to pay a call to hospital after a fall. Visitors Morrie Mattingley and Dud Smith were unable to avoid colliding with the falling Dragon. He wrenched a leg muscle.

Spills and engine failures about the home team's rather narrow defeat in this second leg. After May and Taylor surprised the Saint's with a 5-1 in the opening heat, Croucher and Moore immediately hit back with a similar score to level the points. Not to be denied, the visitors notched a second heat maximum in Heat 3 and from then never lost the lead, despite hard and desperate riding by the home team. Bert Croucher played a captain's part to top the Saints' score chart, but had one blank ride in Heat 16 when he was "filled up" early on and finished last. Second reserve Mike Tams surprised everyone with his spirited riding, After a third in his opening ride, he got going to notch two firsts and two seconds to finish one point behind his captain. Charlie May - one time Southampton rider - and Hugh Geddes featured in the Cardiff team each with three firsts, a second and a third. There was just that little extra strength all round to give them success.

Charlie May showed that he still knows some of the quickest routes around his old track when he led Cardiff to a deserved National Trophy victory. Cardiff won a 133-82 aggregate victory. From the 3rd heat, when Frank Johnson and Chum Taylor scored a spectacular 5-1, the visitors always led. Mattingley was brilliant on occasions, winning three heats. Unfortunately he took too many chances on the rain-soaked surface and fell in his other three races. However, the crowd voiced their approval of his daring in no uncertain manner.
