However, the meeting was then postponed at a late stage as a track licence had not been issued, with the directors explaining that licences were at that time renewed on a weekly basis. A statement issued by the ACU said that 'the Union have decided to withdraw their licence because matters have been so unsatisfactorily conducted on the track in the past'.
