(7) Although Rochdale beat Halifax 33-28 on track, the match was subsequently awarded as a win for Halifax, due to the home side's illegal use of a rider. Despite this, the race points remained unaltered;

(8) Hanley came into the league upon Bolton's withdrawal, but they themselves withdrew after just 5 matches;

(9) Long Eaton also entered the league, but never raced a single match;
