Notes:

(1) Matches were run over nine heats, with a 3-2-1 scoring system;

(2) Having completed 19 matches, Nottingham resigned in July, through being unable to raise a full team. Despite this, their record was retained in the final table;

(3) Having gone into liquidation, Leicester withdrew from the league in April, with Coventry subsequently taking over their outstanding fixtures in mid-May.

(4) Harringay resigned in June, with Belle Vue taking over their remaining matches as well as competing in the Northern League.

(5) The second High Beech v Southampton match was raced at Southampton;

(6) The result of the first Leicester v High Beech match was amended from 28-23 by the ACU, due to an ineligible rider;

(7) The result of the first Wimbledon v Southampton match was amended from 30-23 by the ACU, due to an ineligible rider;

(8) The first Coventry v Nottingham match was awarded as a win to Coventry;

(9) The second Wembley v Coventry match was rained off, but was subsequently awarded as a win for Wembley.
