The Gold Cup looked destined to be won by Eric Langton and Bill Kitchen who had completed their fixtures with 52 points. Only Wilkinson and Atkinson could beat them by going through this event unbeaten.

It looked a tall order but the Hammers pair had a charmed life as the opposition

fell apart. In heat 2 Waln was the only opponent and was outclassed. In heat 4 the Harringay Tigers had a disastrous start.

Ormston stayed where he was as the tapes flew up and Jack Parker struggled slowly away and was hopelessly far behind

Surely Van Praag would at least split them in heat 11. No, Van broke down at the first bend.

Bluey Wilkinson and Arthur Atkinson had won the Gold Cup by a point.
