THOSE who regard this as the best Berwick line-up in several years were given plenty of justification for that view as the bandits made an impressive start to the season.

The home side, beaten by the Brummies' in the equivalent opening fixture last year, took total control with advantages in each of the first five races to go 14 points clear, and they collected all but three of the heat wins throughout the meeting.

New captain Chris Harris started things off by surging inside opposite number Claus Vissing in Heat 1, with two 5-1s following as Jye Etheridge, Kyle Bickley and Leon Flint all launched successful meetings.

Not surprisingly, Adam Ellis was the Brummies' top man, and he put a win on the board for the visitors in Heat 6, but he was also relegated to the back by Flint and Theo Pijper in Heat 9 as Stefan Nielsen took the flag.

With their middle order misfiring and being heavily outscored at reserve, the visitors were never in contention, and Etheridge remained unbeaten after four rides when he linked up with Flint for a 5-1 in Heat 14.

Ellis stopped Etheridge from recording a maximum by taking the final race as Harris hit ignition trouble at the start, but this was a hugely positive night for the Bandit overall.

The two Aussies combined for 5-15 in Heats 13 and 15 with Pickering promoted to No. 5 this season, and the Monarchs were pleased with their overall display o fend off a stubborn Bandits side.

Lasse Fredriksen won Heat 8 ahead of Jye Etheridge on his debut, and Paco Castagna marked his first appearance for the club with a race win too in a fierce scrap with Ricky Wells in Heat 9.

The Bandits, for whom ex- Monarch Theo Pijper offered good support to Wells and Chris Harris, needed a 3-3 from the last race for a league point, but Pickering produced a terrific ride to storm round Harris and join Masters upfront.

BERWICK recorded a second convincing home win of the season, with all seven riders claiming at least one paid win and Jye Etheridge again excelling at reserve.

The Monarchs were limited to just four race wins and found themselves 16 points down after eight races in a total reversal of last year's fixture when the Armadale men ran riot.

After back-to-back Berwick 5- 15, there was some hope for Edinburgh in Heat 9 with Josh Pickering passing Theo Pijper on the last bend for a maximum advantage with Sam Masters — but Chris Harris and Ty Proctor instantly hit back, before Masters was disqualified from Heat 11 after clashing with Etheridge on the first turn, with the result being another Berwick 5-1.

The visitors' night was summed up when Pickering clipped the fence in Heat 15 with his bike careering across the track into Paco Castagna, who was replaced by Masters for the re-run which was taken by the impressive Ricky Wells.

JOSH Auty's Heat 3 crash where he sustained a broken leg led to the abandonment of this match and kept up the Brummies' misfortunes in home meetings so far.

It was he first Perr Barr event of the season not to be affected by the weather, and the hosts made a good start with James Shanes taking the scalp of former skipper Chris Harris in Heat 1.

But after a second Birmingham 4-2 in the reserves' race, Auty lost control on turn four in Heat 3 and slammed into the kickboards just beyond the air-fence.

It was quickly established that would need hospital treatment - but with the need for the paramedic to accompany him, and an incredible six-hour wait being quoted for a county ambulance racing had to be halted.

The incident will doubtless raise concerns around the sport, with Mildenhall having experienced similar problems when they had to secure a new medical team on the day alter a crash in their British Under 21 semi-final and a similar ambulance delay.

GLASGOW showed impressive strength-in-depth in this comfortable home win with reserve Connor Bailey unbeaten after dropping a point in Heat 2.

Jye Etheridge took that race for the Bandits but those were his only points of the night, and Bailey went on to share in two 5-1s, including an excellent Heat 12 when he edged out Theo Pijper on the line after a race-long scrap.

At the top of the order, Craig Cook dropped a point to Ty Proctor in Heat 1 but won each of his battles with opposite number Chris Harris, whilst Ulrich Ostergaard and Tom Brennan both won two races.

The Bandits gave Harris a tactical substitute ride in Heat 9, but Benjamin Basso hit the front for the Tigers who held a 4-2 before Harris passed Ostergaard.

Harris took his second win at the expense of the thrusting Brennan in Heat 11 while Danyon Hume held back Proctor for third. Hume added a win of his own in Heat 14 to compensate for Basso's last place.

EARLY indications are that Shieffield Park is going to be amongst the Championship's toughest venues to visit this season. and that contrast has to be drawn with last September's home match against Kent.

On that occasion, Troy Batchelor and Scott Nicholls racked up 27 (paid 30) for the Kings, but on this occasion for the Cheetahs they were limited to 16+1 between them as Berwick took 12 or the race wins.

There was a paid maximum at reserve for Jye Etherldge, and Chris Harris may well have been unbeaten but for suffering mechanical failure at the start oi Heat 15.

Harris had thrilled the crowd with an incredible outside blast to pass Batchelor in Heat 13, and the Australian's misery was compounded when he suffered engine failure off the last bend and Rickey Wells completed a 5-1.

Etheridge and Leon Flint rode hard for the Bandits seventh maximum advantage in Heat 14, whilst guest Nathan Stoneman was the Cheetah's other race winner aside from the top two, when he defeated Ty Proctor in Heat 8.

Wells held the lead at the second time of asking but was quickly passed on the inside by both King and Richard Lawson, before Harris wound things up and went past King to seemingly rescue the win.

But there was one final twist as his clutch burnt out at the start of the last lap, King came though, and the Pirates picked up two unexpected league points.

Their initial comeback had been sparked by Kemp, who started with two last places but finished with two race wins whilst Ben Cook picked up two wins at reserve.

The result means the Pirates now cannot mathematically catch Leicester at the top — but they still have a chance of second, with last night's (Wednesday) home clash with Glasgow pivotal to that race.

GLASGOW moved back into CJL ascendancy by repeating the feat of Edinburgh one week earlier in coming from behind to win at Berwick. The Bandits had lost a ten-point lead with five races remaining against the Monarchs, and history effectively repeated itself hear as they led 30-27 after Heat 10 and then conceded three 5-1s in the next four races.

Brennan rode superbly to defeat Harris in a shared Heat 13, enabling Basso and Nicol to wrap things up at the expense of Wells in the penultimate race before Harris and Flint knocked the Tigers down from four group points to three with a 5-1 in the last.

The result put Glasgow back in the driving seat in the group, whilst the Bandits continue to struggle at home. The absence of Jonas Knudsen due to his continued visa delay was clearly a major factor in the result.

Thomson and Justin Sedgman followed Harris home in Heats 13 to effectively secure a home win, before Flint rode superbly in Heat 15 to join Harris for a 5-1 to give the Bandits an away point.
