A delay of ten minutes ensued before the three remaining riders reappeared and as they approached the start-line on the preliminary lap Burton and Marsh turned back to the Paddock to effect repairs only for Jackson to receive the signal by the Start Marshal to begin the race much to the astonishment of both Burton and Marsh.
