CHARLES Wright and Erik Riss took Redcar through the 60-point barrier as the Bears ran up a big home win over their North-East rivals. Wright raced to a paid maximum and Riss dropped his only point to Diamonds skipper James Wright in Heat 4, with the two combining for 5-1s in Heats 13 and 15. And with Lewis Kerr recording three straight wins before being disqualified from Heat 12 for not being under power when Lee Complin crashed out, the contrast between a side with three clear heat leaders, and one without, was stark. In fairness to Newcastle they were without Paul Starke due to Covid, with rider replacement hardly adequate cover, whilst Bradley Wilson-Dean endured a tough return to British Speedway as he was on the receiving end of three 5-1s. The aftermath of the first of those, up against Wright and Adam Roynon, resulted in Roynon coming to grief following the chequered flag as Wilson-Dean returned to the pits. Roynon and Wright later notched a 5-1 over the Diamonds' best pairing of James Wright and Max Clegg, who between them won three races for the visitors - whose reserves arguably did not score the points their efforts deserved.

MAX Clegg won this closely fought challenge match for Newcastle just when it looked like Stoke would fight back and take the honours in Dave Tattum Memorial.  
 The Diamonds had led by 10 points despite a tough home debut for new No.1 Bradley Wilson-Dean, with the likes of Clegg, Matthew Wethers and Paul Starke all strong race-winning form.  
 Starke and newcomer George Congreave took a 5-1 in Heat 4 after Ben Barker dropped a chain, and Clegg's defeat of Barker in Heat 9 was the first of successive 4-2s which put the home side 35-25 up.  
 But Barker and Steve Worrall began to get the Potters back into proceedings by heading up 4-2s in Heats 11 and 12, before combining as a pair to get the better of Starke for a 5-1 in Heat 13.  
 Leon Flint defeated Clegg in a shared Heat 14, meaning Barker and Worrall needed a repeat performance to complete the comeback and their task appeared to have been made easier when Starke failed to beat the time allowance, with reserve Lee Complin coming in.  
 But Clegg made the start and held off the Potters' top duo to secure a narrow win for the home side, with the trophy then presented to Tattum's family

LEICESTER exceeded their previous home scores this season in the third one-sided encounter at the Paul Chapman & Sons Arena, although things should get more competitive from this weekend.  
 With No.1 Bradley Wilson-Dean yet to find any form for his new club, the visitors followed Birmingham and Scunthorpe in conceding over 60 points, and their only race win in Heat 4 was a fortunate one.  
 Paul Starke had ridden a strong first bend to get the better of Ritchie Worrall, but the Lions reserve Joe Thompson was the clear leader until he inexplicably slid off on the last lap.  
 There were paid maximums for the home side from Nick Morris and Kyle Howarth, and Connor Mountain was unbeaten against his former club until he ran a last in Heat 15.  
 That was arguably the race of the night as Starke so nearly denied Morris his full score before the Australian came through on the last lap. There were mixed fortunes for the two No. 4s as Dan Thompson enjoyed his best night of the season for Leicester, but Newcastle's Max Clegg surprisingly failed to score on his old home track.

REDCAR'S overall victory in the Tyne-Tees Trophy was never going to be under threat as they held a 31-point lead from the first leg - but Newcastle did at least take some positives from their home performance.  
 The Diamonds, hammered at Leicester the previous evening, could have won on the day having regained the lead with a 5-1 from Heat 14 as Lee Complin took his comeback and was joined by Max Clegg, who passed both guest Tom Woolley and Kasper Andersen.  
 Clegg and Paul Starke then looked set to secure a 3-3 in the last race behind paid maximum man Erik Riss - but Clegg was overtaken on the inside by Lew Kerr, and fell as he tried to respond, so the Bears took a 4-2 for a share of the spoils.  
 Riss, Kerr and Charles Wright won eight races between them with Riss continuing his impressive start to the season, and Jordan Jenkins defeated Complin in Heat 2.  
 There were never more than two points between the sides with Starke, Clegg and Matthew Wethers leading the Way for the Diamonds, who brought in Ricky Wells to guest for Bradley Wilson-Dean at No.1, the New Zealander having been ruled out with shoulder trouble.

THIS was a sadly predictable mismatch with Glasgow having three unbeaten riders and dishing out Newcastle's third 60-plus thrashing on the road so far this season.  
 Tigers boss Cami Brown accepted the Diamonds had their problems, with Paul Starke unfortunate on his return to his old club, but the visitors managed to share just two of the 15 races and couldn't provide a single race win.  
 That statistic could have changed in Heat 10 when Max Clegg and James Wright gated in front, but Cook went from last to first and hit the front going into the third lap on his way to a 15- point full house.  
 Ulrich Ostergaard was also paid for the lot from five rides, holding off James Wright in Heat 15, and Ben Basso completed a debut paid maximum along with three 5-1s with Ostergaard — with Tom Brennan and Connor Bailey also paid for double figures in this one-sided encounter.
