AN all-ticket, sell-out crowd of 2,000, a close contest with four lead changes and a home victory...what more could Oxford have wished for on re-opening night?

Fifteen years on from their last meeting in the old Conference League against the same opponents, the Cheetahs were back — and they made a Winning start to life in the Championship despite trailing for much of the match.

In the end, the home team were thankful for the superiority of top two Troy Batchelor and Scott Nicholls, whose Heat 13 and 15 maximums were enough to send Scunthorpe packing back up north without even a losing bonus point for their night's endeavours.

For two-thirds of the fixture, the Scorpions had threatened to spoil the carnival atmosphere generated by the return of the sport to Cowley. Gifted a 5-0 in Heat 3 following an exclusion for Kyle Newman, who lost control and wiped out Tero Aarnio on the fourth bend of the first lap, and an engine failure for Cameron Heeps in the re-run, Scunthorpe got their noses in front and led for seven of the first nine races.

A Newman breakdown in Heat 9 handed the visitors a 4-2 and a 28-25 lead but after the imperious Batchelor had teamed up with the impressive Jack Thomas for a Heat 10 5-1 that edged Oxford ahead for the first time since Heat 2, the Scorpions swiftly restored their advantage when Ryan Douglas inflicted a first defeat of the night on Nicholls in Heat 11.

They looked set to maintain their one-point lead in Heat 12 but Dillon Ruml picked off Jordan Palin on the last lap for third and the resulting 4-2 nudged Cheetahs back in front at 36-35.

A predictable 5-1 from in-form Batchelor and Nicholls in Heat 13 left Scunthorpe needing a positive result from the penultimate race but with the pointless Newman and Josh Macdonald going out for Oxford, the contest was by no means over. Macdonald got all out of shape on the second corner, but baulked Zaine Kennedy in the process, and that actually worked in the home side's favour as Macdonald recovered to follow his partner home for a 3-3 which all but settled the issue.

Douglas briefly led the last heat but both Nicholls and Batchelor swept past at the end of the first lap to wrap up the three league points for the Cheetahs.

POOLE put on another big home performance in front of a bumper Easter crowd at Wimborne Road, and their winter move for Richard Lawson continues to pay major dividends.
 Lawson collected his second maximum of the season for the Pirates, who got off to an ideal start with a 5-1 over Troy Batchelor in Heat 1, and the most damaging run for the Cheetahs came with maximums in Heats 9, 10 and 11 to extend the gap beyond 20 points.
 There could have been a second unbeaten home rider, but Steve Worrall was edged out by Scott Nicholls in Heat 15 and then dropped beyond Dillon Ruml due to a late puncture, whilst Drew Kemp kept up his fine start to the season with his only setback coming when he dropped a chain at the start of Heat 8.
 Nathan Stoneman stood in for the injured Josh Macdonald for the visitors and took a decent second place in Heat 2 ,Ai but then clashed with Nathan Ablitt in Heat 12 with the Poole rider disqualified after causing Stoneman to come down off turn four.

WITH rivalry renewed after a 15-year gap, those two sides Put on a nip-and-tuck affair with the Pirates finishing strongly to become the first away side to win at Cowley.

The looked comfortable from the off with three of the first four race wins, including Zach Cook's pass on Kyle Newman to take Heat 1, and with Danny King taking Heats 4 and 6 the visitors were six points up.

But the Cheetahs stormed back level through a 5-1 from Jack Thomas and Dillon Ruml in Heat 8 after Troy Batchelor won a tactical substitute ride one race earlier.

Thomas then held King at bay for a notable victory in Heat 9 which put the home side in front at 28-26.

The match turned again in Heat 11 with Cook beating Scott Nicholls for a 5-1 with Steve Worrall, and the Pirates picked u a useful 4-2 in Heat 13 as Nichols stopped on lap three, enabling King, who had been an early faller to inherit third place.

The away win was secured by Drew Kemp and Ben Cook with a 5-1 in Heat 14 which gave Poole an unassailable lead, but the Pirates were limited to three league points when Worrall was kept at the back of Heat 15 with Batchelor defeating Richard Lawson.

EARLY indications are that Shieffield Park is going to be amongst the Championship's toughest venues to visit this season. and that contrast has to be drawn with last September's home match against Kent.
 On that occasion, Troy Batchelor and Scott Nicholls racked up 27 (paid 30) for the Kings, but on this occasion for the Cheetahs they were limited to 16+1 between them as Berwick took 12 or the race wins.
 There was a paid maximum at reserve for Jye Etheridge, and Chris Harris may well have been unbeaten but for suffering mechanical failure at the start oi Heat 15.
 Harris had thrilled the crowd with an incredible outside blast to pass Batchelor in Heat 13, and the Australian's misery was compounded when he suffered engine failure off the last bend and Rickey Wells completed a 5-1.
 Etheridge and Leon Flint rode hard for the Bandits seventh maximum advantage in Heat 14, whilst guest Nathan Stoneman was the Cheetah's other race winner aside from the top two, when he defeated Ty Proctor in Heat 8.

OXFORD secured their first away win of the club's new era, with their Heat 15 5-1 at Brough Park also being enough to take all four league points.

But whilst their pre-season expectations would have been for their last-heat deciders to be contested by Scott Nicholls and Troy Batchelor, on this occasion it was an inspired Jack Thomas who teamed up with Nicholls to bring home the points for the Cheetahs - and the contribution of Dillon Ruml at reserve was also vital.

Newcastle held an early four- point lead with Max Clegg repassing Batchelor to join James Wright up-front in Heat 5, but a topsy-turvy match was level again two races later when home guest Tom Brennan was disqualified after clashing with Kyle Newman.

The dropped point came in Heat 8 when Lee Complin was disqualified and Ruml fell on the last lap of the re-run, but the American hit back to partner Batchelor to a key 5-1 in Heat 11.

The Cheetahs went seven points up, only to be forced into a nervous finale by a 5-1 from home guests Brennan and Richie Worrall in Heat 13, but the decider turned into a procession for the visitors after the Diamonds riders tangled with Wright falling and Worrall reduced to coasting speed.

Nicol was in the wars again in Heat 8, going down with Dillon Ruml at the first bend, but referee Willie Dishington ruled all four back. An emerging pattern of Oxford providing the first man home and the Tigers filling the minor places continued in the re-run as Summers took the flag for a third time, and was followed home by Danyon Hume and Nicol. Cook ended the sequence with a vital win in Heat 11 but again the race was shared, and the outstanding Hume, undoubtedly the man of the match, came up with a big three points for Glasgow in the next to keep the scores level for an eighth consecutive race. Tigers finally broke the deadlock with a 4-2 in Heat 13 from Cook and Tom Brennan and seemed on course for Victory when Hume led a 4-2 in the penultimate heat - only for Ruml to sneak past the visiting No.6 off the last corner. It would prove crucial in the final reckoning. Batchelor muscled Cook out around the opening bends of Heat 15 and Harris capitalised surge into second, the home pairing then team riding their way to a match-winning 5-1 despite the ever-pressing Cook's desperate efforts to find a way past.

That effectively put Plymouth into the entire contest with just four riders, and in the circumstances they did well to keep things as competitive as they did.
Fortunately, with Josh Pickering taking a guest booking and racing in nearly half of the heats, there was still plenty of entertainment as the Australian piled up 17 points, although he was upstaged by the home side's top two of Scott Nicholls and Troy Batchelor in Heat 13.
Nicholls scored a four-ride maximum and the home side will also have been encouraged by Paul Starke's best display since joining the club, and three wins in his first three rides for Cameron Heeps.
Guests James Wright and Jake Mulford also won races for the Gladiators, who ended the meeting with just one of their regular rides - and even Ben Morley himself was an injury replacement earlier in the season!
