RYAN Douglas fought what wasn't far off a one-man battle on his old home track as Leicester topped the 60-point mark for the second time in two meetings.

Douglas scored half of the Scorpions' points and ended the nine-race winning run of Richie Worrall in Heat 15, by which point he had already stopped then maximum aspirations of Nick Morris and Kyle Howarth, the latter by taking the flag in Heat 5.

However, Howarth hit back by going between Douglas and Allen in Heat 9 when the visiting No. 1 was taking a tactical substitute ride, and Worrall got inside Douglas on the run to the line in an excellent Heat 13.

The Lions recorded six 5-1s, three of them involving Connor Mountain and four involving Joe Thompson, with the pair combining for a dramatic end to Heat 8 when both made it past Zaine Kennedy off the final bend.

Scunthorpe suffered 13 last places and it was a bad night for Jake Allen, who was disqualified in an unusual Heat 4 incident as he appeared to put the bike down on turn four when Thompson looked to be in trouble in front of him.

Tero Aarnio also came to grief in Heat 10 as he lost control on the third bend after Morris had surged inside him, and skipper Simon Lambert failed to score from four rides to sum up the visitors' night.

AN all-ticket, sell-out crowd of 2,000, a close contest with four lead changes and a home victory...what more could Oxford have wished for on re-opening night?

Fifteen years on from their last meeting in the old Conference League against the same opponents, the Cheetahs were back — and they made a Winning start to life in the Championship despite trailing for much of the match.

In the end, the home team were thankful for the superiority of top two Troy Batchelor and Scott Nicholls, whose Heat 13 and 15 maximums were enough to send Scunthorpe packing back up north without even a losing bonus point for their night's endeavours.

For two-thirds of the fixture, the Scorpions had threatened to spoil the carnival atmosphere generated by the return of the sport to Cowley. Gifted a 5-0 in Heat 3 following an exclusion for Kyle Newman, who lost control and wiped out Tero Aarnio on the fourth bend of the first lap, and an engine failure for Cameron Heeps in the re-run, Scunthorpe got their noses in front and led for seven of the first nine races.

A Newman breakdown in Heat 9 handed the visitors a 4-2 and a 28-25 lead but after the imperious Batchelor had teamed up with the impressive Jack Thomas for a Heat 10 5-1 that edged Oxford ahead for the first time since Heat 2, the Scorpions swiftly restored their advantage when Ryan Douglas inflicted a first defeat of the night on Nicholls in Heat 11.

They looked set to maintain their one-point lead in Heat 12 but Dillon Ruml picked off Jordan Palin on the last lap for third and the resulting 4-2 nudged Cheetahs back in front at 36-35.

A predictable 5-1 from in-form Batchelor and Nicholls in Heat 13 left Scunthorpe needing a positive result from the penultimate race but with the pointless Newman and Josh Macdonald going out for Oxford, the contest was by no means over. Macdonald got all out of shape on the second corner, but baulked Zaine Kennedy in the process, and that actually worked in the home side's favour as Macdonald recovered to follow his partner home for a 3-3 which all but settled the issue.

Douglas briefly led the last heat but both Nicholls and Batchelor swept past at the end of the first lap to wrap up the three league points for the Cheetahs.

THERE would have been long odds against this result when Leicester led 25-23 after eight races — having won each of the last ten clashes between the clubs.

But the final seven heats transformed the contest with the Scorpions producing a stunning run of four successive 5-1s, one of the hero's being reserve Ryan Kinsley who got the better of Nick Morris from the back in Heat 11, and then shared in another 5-1 over Richie Worrall in Heat 14.

Nothing worked out for the Lions, who saw Morris lose out to Jordan Palin and Zaine Kennedy when on a tactical substitute, and Tero Aarnio snatched third place from Morris on the line in Heat 13 for a 4-2 with Ryan Douglas.

The Scorpions' No. 1 tangled with Connor Mountain on the first bend of Heat 1 but after losing out to Morris in the re-run, he was unbeaten for the remainder of the meeting, as Scunthorpe celebrated a most notable victory.

BACK-TO-BACK 5-1s in Heats 3 and 4 pointed Scunthorpe in the direction of their second consecutive home win, but it was only in the closing stages that the Scorpions managed to pull clear of battling Birmingham.

The Brummies hit hard by the loss of broken leg victim Josh Auty two nights earlier, never really threatened to upset the applecourt with a shock away win, but they were certainly in the running for a consolation losing bonus point with four heats to go.

When Claus Vissing, a constant thorn in the home team's side after an opening race last, and James Shanes teamed up for a 4-2 in Heat 11, it trimmed Scunthorpe's lead to 37-29.

Vissing and former Scorpions No.1 Adam Ellis were then handed a 4-2 two races later when leader Ryan Douglas broke down on the last corner.

But it all counted for nothing thanks to a barnstorming Scunthorpe finale that yielded three 5-1s in the last four heats, two of them involving free-scoring reserve Zaine Kennedy.

Vissing, Ellis and Shanes shouldered most of the load for the visitors, although there was also an impressive tapes-to-flag win for rookie No.7 James Pearson in Heat 2.

the home side were always likely to have too much in the tank, however, and so it proved with the feisty Tero Aarnio top scoring on 12+1 and Douglas and Kennedy also hitting double figures.

At 39-39, a last heat decider was already guaranteed but first came a strange 14th race, which ultimately decided the final outcome.

Poole's luck was out when Ben Cook shed a chain as the tapes

With Coles excluded as the cause of the stoppage, and Cook ruled out for not being under power, it meant a match race between Allen and Ablitt — and there was only going to be one winner of that particular contest.

Allen's third race win gave Scunthorpe a crucial one—point lead to defend in the final heat and despite Allen almost crashing on the second bend second time around, his team-mate Douglas managed to get his nose in front and held on under intense pressure from King to seal the narrowest of victories.

DID battered and bruised Redcar enact the most remarkable of fightbacks or did injury-hit Scunthorpe snatch defeat from the jaws of victory? Either way three successive 5-1s, that few saw coming created one of the sport's most dramatic comebacks from the dead to leave the race for a play-off place on a knife edge.

Jenkins virtually had to be lifted onto his bike before bravely leading a tenacious Newman home for another maximum and, after Kerr had been pulled up for jumping the first attempt to get the decisive Heat 15 underway, the recently crowned Championship Pairs winners, emphatically left Scunthorpe wondering what had hit them with another dominant and match-snatching 5-1 in the re-run.

Wright finished with paid ten and Jenkins nine, while Roynon, unbeaten in his first four outings, was the only Scarp beat Kerr on the way to season's best 11+1, with Allen paid for ten and Lawson nine.
